# Make a Butterfly Feeder

## Materials

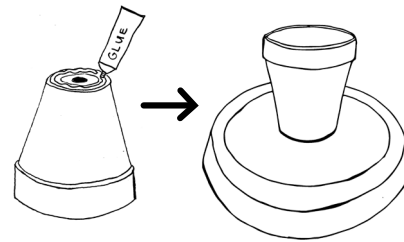


## Materials Checklist

- One 5" Terracotta Pot
- One 12" Terracotta Saucer
- Colorful Craft Paints
- Paint Brushes
- Liquid Nails Adhesive
- Drop Cloth

### STEP 1: GLUE POT TO SAUCER

Apply glue to the bottom of the terracotta pot, then press the center of the saucer down onto the glued area. Let the glue set to attach the pot and saucer.



### STEP 2: PAINT BASE COAT

Once the pot and saucer are securely glued, paint them a bright base color like yellow, orange, or red.

### STEP 3: DECORATE IT!

Get creative with the paint job! You can use stencils to paint flowers, animals, shapes, anything the kids are into!

For maximum butterfly fun, place the feeder in the garden near plants that attract butterflies, like salvia, lantana, and alyssum.



### STEP 4: PLACE THE FEEDER IN THE GARDEN

Place the butterfly feeder in your garden, nearby flowers if you can. Add sugar water, fruit, or both, to the saucer to attract butterflies.
